Dear Newman Parishioners,

Loaves & Fishes wants you to know that we really appreciate your generous donations and support of Newman Hall-Holy Spirit Parish's ministry to feed the homeless/needy. During the first six months of 2021 L&F served meals to 389 Guests for an average monthly attendance of 64.8. Adding the 66 meals delivered by Night On-the-Street Catholic Worker to those unable to get to Newman brings the total to 455 people served, or an average of 75.8 per month. Our expenses for food, spices, recyclable packaging and paper products totaled \$4,869.67, or \$10.70 per Guest.

During 2020 L&F served meals to 946 Guests for an average monthly attendance of 78.8. Adding in the 150 meals delivered by NOSCW brings the total to 1,096 people served, or an average of 91.3 per month. Expenses totaled \$15,728, or \$14.34 per Guest.
